BYOT workshop, AGM and June Meeting

Turnout for the BYOT workshop was not as good as for last year's event on the same Saturday in June: however, the half dozen Members that did participate made good progress on their trees. The guidance of senior OBS Members was much appreciated. Duart reports that the undercut graft he attempted seems to be taking.

The AGM and June meeting followed the workshop. Yvon reported on the past year's highlights which included three workshops, the annual show, membership growth (26 new members !), and a significant improvement in operating costs. The Steering Group feels that although the OBS made it "into the black" in 2003/2004, we still need to build reserves through profitable activities in the coming fiscal year.

The new Group met on June 21 to plan activities that will stimulate membership interest and generate revenue.

Subsequently, OBS Members will be contacted to determine what trees they would like to display and what assistance they can offer with the setup, staffing, and dismantling the show. Please get those finished bonsai in shape for September! Subject to approval of the Embassy, the Steering Group will schedule the September OBS Meeting at the end of the first day of the show (i.e. at 4 pm on Saturday, September 11th). This Meeting may be followed by a social event (perhaps at a nice restaurant) that could recognize the indulgence of long-suffering spouses, partners, etc for our obsession with trees in pots.

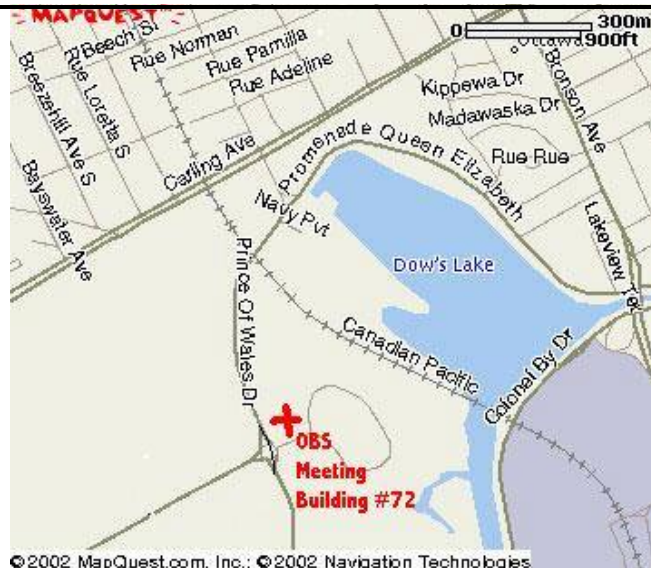

Meeting Location / Lieu des rencontres

Nos rencontres se tiennent à l'édifice #72 de la Ferme expérimentale centrale. Pour vous y rendre, prenez la direction sud sur la promenade Prince of Wales jusqu'au rond-point à l'intersection National Capital Driveway et Prince of Wales (qui est aussi l'entrée principale de la Ferme expérimentale et de l'Arboretum), où vous prendrez la direction Est menant à l'Arboretum. Une courte distance plus loin, à la première fourche, Prenez la route de gauche qui mène directement à l'édifice #72 (vous verrez une affiche juste en face de l'édifice, de l'autre côté du chemin, qui dit «Friends of the Farm»). Le stationnement est situé de part et d'autre de l'édifice.



Our meetings are held at Building #72 at the Central Experimental Farm. Heading south on Prince of Wales, at the traffic circle at the intersection of the N.C.C. Scenic Drive and Prince of Wales, the major entrance to the Experimental Farm and the Arboretum, exit east into the Arboretum. After a very short distance, where the road divides, turn left to Building #72 which will be down a short distance on your left. There is parking just before or just after the building. The entrance is on the street side (east side) and there is a sign reading "Friends of the Farm".
